1) The first feature I would like to highlight is Spotify's search engine optimization (SEO). Complementary to the application's extensive archive of content is its user-friendly and sophisticated search capabilities. 2) The next feature would be Spotify's mobile settings customization tools. The user's settings feature is distinguished by its detailed options pertaining to not how the app looks but how the user listens. For example: the Crossfade bar is a unique function in that the user may select how their music may transition audibly from the end of a song into the next song that they have queued. This tool is significant in that by the discretion of the user, there can be little to no lull of silence between the end of a track and the beginning of another one. This option, when activated, grants the user a simplified screen of navigation for when you take your tunes on the road.
